



**Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students Under the
Coronavirus AID, Relief, and Economic Security
(CARES) Act**

APPLICATION FOR A STUDENT EMERGENCY RELIEF GRANT

The federal stimulus legislation known as the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (“CARES Act”), Pub. L. No. 116-136, signed into law by the President on March 27, 2020, includes relief to institutions and students for costs associated with the coronavirus emergency. Specifically, the CARES Act established the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (“HEERF”), under which the U.S. Department of Education (“ED”) has allocated formula grant funds to institutions. NETTTS has received an allocation of these funds from ED. Therefore, NETTTS is making emergency financial aid grants available to students of our institution who need financial support for their expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to Coronavirus.

This application permits students who are eligible or could be eligible to participate in the federal student aid programs to apply for these need-based grants. If you have filed a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), NETTTS has the information to determine if you meet this requirement. If you have not filed a FAFSA, you should contact the financial aid office at NETTTS as soon as possible so they can assist you in filing a FAFSA.

Campus administration will use the information you provide here to determine your eligibility for a grant. Each student will be eligible for only one grant, and only one application will be considered per student. Please fill out this information neatly and completely and provide it to your campus in person.

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

1. Students must have been enrolled in one of NETTTS’ Title IV approved programs (CDL600 or HVACR Technology) prior to March 27, 2020.
2. Student must have been registered as “Active” status on March 27, 2020.
3. Student must meet federal eligibility requirements to receive Title IV funding.
4. Student must complete the Application and present to the NETTTS financial aid office.
